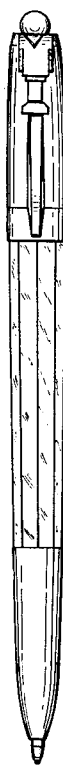


FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a ball point pen showing my new design, the side opposite thereto being similar in appearance; and
